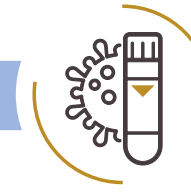
Verify your entry status

You can enter Abu Dhabi if you are a UAE national or resident, or if you are eligible for a visa on arrival. Residents are encouraged to visit uaeentry.ica.gov.ae to verify their entry status before they book.



Book your flight

We're flying to and from Asia, Australia, Europe, the Middle East and North America. Find out more and book your flight at etihad.com.



Arrange a COVID-19 PCR test

You must have a COVID-19 PCR test at any government accredited medical facility 96 hours before your flight. Timing may vary for some destinations. Remember to print your test result as you'll need to present it at check-in.

Photocopy your passport and visa

Take a photocopy of your passport and UAE resident visa – you'll need to present this when you return to Abu Dhabi.

Remember to check the latest travel regulations before you fly – this is really important to keep you safe and avoid any disruptions to your journey.

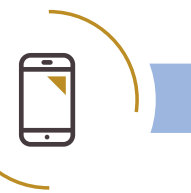

When you land in Abu Dhabi



Visit the Abu Dhabi health check desk

You'll undergo thermal screening and COVID-19 PCR testing when you land at Abu Dhabi airport. This applies to all guests, including infants and children.



Download the Al Hosn app

Remember to download the Al Hosn app, the UAE's official COVID-19 results and contact tracing app.



Quarantine for 14 days

You must self-isolate at home or at a hotel* for 14 days if you stay in Abu Dhabi. You will be required to wear a medically approved wristband for the duration.**



Travel to another emirate

If you are travelling to another emirate including Dubai, you will simply need to follow the quarantine rules of that emirate. You will only be permitted to travel to another emirate by Etihad Chauffeur, Etihad Express Coach or Airport Taxi.

*If you are arriving from a country deemed high-risk by the UAE authorities you may be subject to quarantine at a government facility.

**UAE residents and nationals in Phase III of the vaccine trials or taking part in the National Vaccination Programme are exempt from quarantine on arrival to Abu Dhabi.
