I, _____, an Official Veterinarian for the Government of Australia certify to the best of my knowledge that:

1. The export country (Australia) has not recorded Rabies for at least the two years prior to export.
2. The age of the dog(s)/cat(s) was not less than 15 weeks of age at the time of export.
3. Vaccinations:
 - i. The animal(s) have been vaccinated for rabies, at not less than three months of age and not less than 21 days prior to export in accordance with the manufacturer's recommendations.
 - ii. The dog(s) have been vaccinated against the following disease: Canine Distemper Virus (CDV), Canine Parvovirus, Infectious Canine Hepatitis and tested negative within 30 days prior to export for Leptospirosis (*Leptospira canicola* and *Leptospira icterohaemorrhagiae*).
